



#### **2% HST TAX CUT**

We will cut the HST to 14% in 2025, and then to 13% in 2026. When fully implemented, this 2% tax cut will save the average New Brunswick family \$1000 per year.



#### **FASTER ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE**

We will expand the scope of practice for nurses, paramedics, and pharmacists in order to speed up care and help doctors be available for cases that absolutely require their attention.



#### NO NEW DRUG INJECTION SITES

We will not approve any new supervised injection sites in the province. And we will consult with communities about whether to close existing sites.



#### FINANCIAL LITERACY IN OUR SCHOOLS

We will set our children up for success in life by providing them a basic understanding of personal finance.



#### **RESPECT PARENTS**

We respect parents, and believe government should not be in charge of raising kids. Our policies reflect that.



#### DEFEND LANDOWNERSHIP

The provincial government is being sued to assert Aboriginal title over the entire province. We are committed to reconciliation and working with First Nations., but treaties have already settled this matter. We will defend landowners in court.



#### **AXE THE CARBON TAX**

We will fight the Trudeau carbon tax legally and politically. And we will never implement a consumer carbon tax.



#### **BALANCE THE BUDGET**

After six years of a PC government, \$2.5 billion of debt has already been repaid. Our provincial credit rating has been repaired, and we are able to invest more in New Brunswick's future.



#### **INVEST IN ADDICTION TREATMENT**

Treatment and recovery are the best way to help those suffering from addiction. We will intervene and compel individuals into drug treatment when they pose a threat to themselves or others.



#### **SAFER COMMUNITY SPACES**

An improved Community Investment Fund will protect not-for-profit community facilities. It's our duty to ensure these critical spaces remain safe and secure.



#### **SUPPORT NURSES**

We will launch a Working Group on improving working conditions for nurses. We will also pay 50% of Registered Nurses' Long-Term Disability premiums for 2 years.
